## INTRODUCTION

The 3<sup>rd</sup> International Meeting on Asian Zoo/ Wildlife Medicine and Conservation (AZWMC) is as the continuation of two previous meeting held in Thailand (2006) and Taiwan (2007), initiated by the Asian Society of Zoo and Wildlife Medicine and Asian Society of Wildlife Pathology. This Meeting will be conducted as Joint Meeting with the 10<sup>th</sup> Indonesian Veterinary Scientific Conference of Indonesia Veterinary Medical Association 2008.

Currently, the global issues in the Veterinary Medicine and Conservation are the (1) wildlife conservation and animal welfare, concerning with the existence of wildlife species all over the world that is extremely threatened because of intensive poaching, habitat destruction and conversion; and (2) wildlife emerging diseases which transferred through/to wildlife species.

Those two important issues need solution through integrated participation of scientists and practitioner of diverse disciplines such as veterinarian (pathologist, epidemiologist, ect), biologist, ecologist, and policy maker; and also through the application of the recent and advanced knowledge and techniques that has been developed very fast recently (wildlife emerging diseases, new techniques in handling and restraint, anesthesia, diagnose methods, treatment, drug use, clinical and pathological cases) for the wildlife medicine and conservation in order to keep those species can long life survive, healthy and sustain.

## GOALS

The 3<sup>rd</sup> AZWMC Meeting aims to (1) provide, deliver and learn the recent and advanced knowledge and techniques of the zoo/ wildlife medicine and conservation in order to keep the wildlife, environment and people in harmony; (2) encourage sharing information and experiences among the zoo/ wildlife veterinarian and researchers of diverse disciplines; and (3) initiate collaboration among scientist, researchers and practisioners.

## THEME

The Unity in Biodiversity

## SCOPES

The scope of this meeting is in the fields of zoo/ wildlife medicine and conservation, including: management, reproduction, diseases, pathology; epidemiology, ect; zoo/ wildlife environment; and the health and basic education on wildlife medicine and conservation.

## PARTICIPANTS

The participants are veterinarian (working as clinicians, researchers, lecturers), scientist/ researchers (biologist, primatologist, pathologist, microbiologist, epidemiologist, ecologist), policy maker and those concern with zoo/ wildlife medicine and conservation.

## PROGRAMS

The 3<sup>rd</sup> International AZWMC meeting will be held from August 19<sup>th</sup> till the 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2008. Programs including : (1) Scientific Programs that will be conducted on August 19<sup>th</sup>-20<sup>th</sup>, (2) Bogor city tour will be available for all participants free of charge on the 21<sup>st</sup> of August, and (3) Country tour to Puncak, Tea Plantation and Safari Park Indonesia will be organized for all participants who are interested and registered to the organizing committee, and it will be charged.

**The Scientific Programs** of AZWMC 2008 will accommodate a range of different session-types. The official language of the scientific meeting will be English.

- **Plenary Sessions.** There will be keynotes speaker (Minister of the Indonesian Ministry of Forestry) and six (6) plenary speakers invited by the meeting committee: Dr. Yasuhiro Yoshikawa (Tokyo University, Japan), Dr. Hideki Endo (Tokyo University, Japan), Dr. Robin Redliff (Cornel University, USA), Dr. Dondin Sajuthi (Bogor Agricultural University, Indonesia), Dr. Darin Colins (Woodland Park Zoo, USA), Dr. Ani Mardiasuti (Bogor Agricultural University, Indonesia).
- **General Sessions.** Oral presentations, each of 20 minutes (including questions). Oral presentations not assigned on submission or by invitation of meeting organizer(s) to a specific topic session, will be allocated to a Poster Session.
- **Poster Sessions.** Poster Sessions will take place during the symposium. Opportunities to view and present posters will be extensive, and posters are regarded as equivalent to oral presentations.
- **Other Sessions.** Upon request to the Scientific Committee, further sessions may be accommodated such as Workshops, Roundtable Discussions, Satellite meeting and Video/DVD Sessions.

## SHORT PAPER SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

**Short Paper for Oral and Poster Presentation.** A short paper must be written in English on MS Word (doc) file, **10pt Arial font**, maximum **2 pages**; containing Introduction, Methods, Results and Discussion, Conclusions, References (max 4 of the most relevant



references) and a maximum of 5 keywords. Acknowledgement of funding sources may be included if space allows.

**Posters.** posters should be exactly **90 cm width x 120 cm height**, and should include the title, all authors, institutional affiliation, abstract, short introduction, methods, results and discussion, conclusion and maximum of 4 major references. Due to constraints on the number of simultaneous sessions, submissions for oral presentations may be assigned to poster sessions. Poster sessions will be dedicated sessions, where you will attend your poster and will be expected to answer questions about your research. Poster sessions are equivalent to oral presentations.

**Submission of the Short Paper:** The short paper must be submitted by email to **AZWMC2008@yahoo.com**, at the latest by **30<sup>th</sup> of May 2008**. First author will be notified of the acceptance by the **15<sup>th</sup> of June 2008**. Delegates making an oral or poster presentation may also contribute to workshop/roundtable sessions. The online submission system will be active from **30<sup>th</sup> of February 2008**.

**Workshops and Roundtable Discussions:** Those wishing to organize one of these sessions should submit information about the proposed Workshop or Roundtable Discussion (title, a list of participants, and a 500 word abstract) via the session submission section of the Scientific Committee. The deadline for submission for review is the **30<sup>th</sup> of April, 2008**.

**Registration fee** will covers scientific meeting materials, lunches and snacks during the meeting and Bogor City Tour.

of Wildlife Pathology that of ¥ 50,000 for each participant, and it will be paid as the reimbursement when you attend the 3<sup>rd</sup> AZWMC meeting by obtaining your receipts for flight and other expenses related to your participation at the AZWMC meeting site .

MEETING VENUE

The 3<sup>rd</sup> AZWMC 2008 meeting will be held in Bogor city, 60 km to the south of Jakarta, the Indonesian capital city. Bogor city is famous in the world because of the extensive botanical garden and the beautiful presidential palace. The botanical garden stretch out over 87 hectares, parts carefully manicured like the palace gardens, parts seeming like wild jungle at first glance, with lakes, two rivers and hilly trails. There is also a large greenhouse housing orchids of all shapes and sizes from different wild and hybrid types. The venue of symposium is just across the botanical garden in walking distance, and at the place where you can easily access the biggest and modern shopping center in Bogor. Near by the Bogor city, you could visit the beautiful view of Puncak (highland and tea plantation) where you can enjoy the natural views beneath the Gede-Pangrango mountain, the largest tea plantation in Indonesia and visit the tea processing at the tea factory within the Puncak area; and also to visit the Indonesian Safari Park (Taman Safari Indonesia) where you can have marvelous experiences and nice view of both the Indonesian endemic and world wildlife species just a few minute driving from the tea plantation.
